# “In the Beginning”

## Intro:

- A. Text: Genesis 1:1, 27
- B. “C\_\_\_\_\_” is a very important word. In Hebrew the word “B\_\_\_\_\_” is special. It refers ONLY to G\_\_\_\_\_ creative acts. It is found passages like Gen 1:1,27, Isaiah 40:28, 45:7-8,15, Psa 148:5, et al

## I. W\_\_\_\_\_ Did He C\_\_\_\_\_ ?

- A. He created \_\_\_\_\_  
Genesis 1:1 - “God created the H\_\_\_\_\_ & E\_\_\_\_\_”  
Hebrews 3:4 - “He who B\_\_\_\_\_ all things is God”  
Hebrews 11:3 - “we understand that the W\_\_\_\_\_ were framed by the word of God” (ESV = “Universe”)
- B. *“If we do not know God as the C\_\_\_\_\_ of A\_\_\_\_\_ things, then we do not know the True God”* (J. Cottrell)
- C. The Bible does not begin by arguing that God exists, it simply declares He is and He is the Creator.

## II. He C\_\_\_\_\_ M\_\_\_\_\_

- A. Much can be learned about God by looking at His creation. His greatest creation is in Genesis 1:26-27
- B. In Him we find our origin story. He created us in the “I\_\_\_\_\_” of God.
  1. It is a M\_\_\_\_\_ likeness (think, feel, choose)
  2. It is a M\_\_\_\_\_ likeness
  3. It is a S\_\_\_\_\_ likeness
