| | Mon | Acts 9:32-43 | The major character is Peter again, as he heals Aeneas, raises Dorcas, |
| | Tue | Acts 10:1- 10:48 | Peter preaches to the first Gentiles— Cornelius and his audience. |
| | Wed | Acts 11:1-11:18 | Peter defends his actions to the other Apostles and brethren in Judea. |
| | Thur | Acts 11:19-30 | Because of persecution, the church is scattered to different place, taking the gospel with them. Barnabas and Paul (Saul) go to Antioch. Note the first use of the word “Christian” in 11:26. |
| | Fri | Acts 12:1-25 | Chapter 12 is another story of victory over persecution. |
| | Sat | Acts 13:1-52 | Chapter 13 tells of the beginning of Paul's first evangelistic journey. In this reading, Luke shifts his emphasis from the work of Peter to that of Paul, following the outline given by Jesus in Acts 1:8 to show how the gospel went from Jerusalem to Rome. |
