Sept 2-8		On Sundays and Wednesdays review lessons from that day	
Memory Verses: 2 Corinthians 5:1 2 Corinthians 5:7 2 Corinthians 5:10 2 Corinthians 5:21	Monday	Pleasant Aroma (2 Cor 2 14-17) How do you smell? (Take a good whiff) Paul likens sharing and obeying God's word to a beautiful fragrance.	
	Tuesday	Things Not Seen (2 Cor 4:7-9, 16-18) Inward faith sustains like unseen supports in a building. Coming up from the foundation (Christ), providing strength. Although hard pressed outwardly, nothing can crush our spirit. Although the outward decays, faith is renewed.	
	Thursday	Repentance (2 Cor 7:9-11) What is the difference between godly sorrow and sorrow of the world? In the latter one is sorry he got caught. The other makes one realize their sins effect their relationship with God and causes real change (repentance).	
	Friday	Joyous Giving (2 Cor 9:6-15) You can't out-give God, but can give like God. Bountifully (v.6) Purposefully & Cheerfully (v.7) Liberally (v.11,13)	
	Saturday	Paul's Boasting (2 Cor 11:22-33) What have I done for Christ? Often we are too afraid to do something as little as ask someone to worship.

Memory Verses: Galatians 2:20 Galatians 5:22-23 Ephesians 4:4-6	Monday	Another Gospel (Gal 1:6-9) In the inspired scriptures we have all we need. Do not be deceived by latter day revelations. Know your Bible!	
	Tuesday	In Christ (Gal 3:26-29) All blessings are "in Christ" (Eph 1:3) Salvation is "in Christ" (Rom 6:23). How does someone get "into Christ"? (27)	
	Thursday	Our Peace (Eph 2:11-18) Peace is a beautiful word! Through Jesus' blood peace is achieved. Jew & Gentile alike have access to the Father.	
	Friday	7 Ones (Eph 4:1-6) Unity is important to God. It happens only when one believes vs. 4-6 and therefore practices the attributes of v. 2.	
	Saturday	Imitators of God (Eph 5:1-7) We are to be holy (set apart). We can never achieve God's perfection, but we can develop godly traits.

Memory Verses: Philippians 4:4 Philippians 4:8-9 Philippians 4:13 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18	Monday	Think on These (Phil 4:8-9) We are what we think about (read Prov 23:7) How important is it then to think on these kinds of things.	
	Tuesday	Preeminent Christ (Col 1:13-18) Christ is: King (13), Redeemer (14), God (15), Creator of All (16), Sustainer (17) Head over His Church (18)	
	Thursday	Good Examples (1Thess 1:2-10) Paul praised the Thessalonians' labor, love, & patience (v.3), their courageous & contagious faith (v.6-8). Do we live in such a way that people can thank God for the example we are setting? If they follow our steps, where would it lead them?	
	Friday	Words of Comfort (1 Thess 4:13-18) Scriptures can bring comfort. They reassure us & teach us. What will really take place when he comes?	
	Saturday	He is Coming (1 Thess 5:1-11) Though it will take us by surprise, we need not fear. Notice "comfort" is again mentioned (v.11). Verse 4 is the key thought. It's message is simple: You know He is coming, but not when, so always be prepared.	
Sept 23-29		On Sundays and Wednesdays review lessons from that day	
Memory Verses: 1 Timothy 4:12 1 Timothy 6:10 2 Timothy 2:15 2 Timothy 3:16-17	Monday	Work! (2 Thess 3:10-15) Laziness was a problem in Thessalonica. People wanted bread, but didn't want to work for it. Paul tells us this attitude is sinful. Christians serve God and honor Him in all things, therefore "whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord" (Col 3:23-24)	
	Tuesday	He Saves Sinners (1 Tim 1:15-17) We all need to remember, that if we were perfect His sacrifice wouldn't have been needed. Never let us have a "holier than thou" attitude. We are all sinners saved by the grace of God. So let us tell all men about the great King eternal!	
	Thursday	Contentment (1 Tim 6:6-10, 17-19) It is the "love of money" that is condemned here (v.10), and it leads "to all kinds of evil." Love for God, however, leads to contentment (v.6) and true riches (v. 17,19). "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be there also" (Mt 6:21)	
	Friday	Pass it On (2 Tim 2:2) Lois & Eunice taught Timothy (1:5, 3:15). Paul furthered his education (v.2). Christianity is a taught religion! (Rm 10:17)	
	Saturday	The "God-Breathed" Word (2 Tim 3:14-17) The word was given for: 1. Doctrine, so we can know what to teach. 2. Reproof, so we can point out error. 3. Correction, so we can fix error. 4. Instruction in righteousness, so we can know how to live. How important is it then to Know Your Bible? (Read 2 Tim 2:15)
