# Power of One Word

## Intro:

- A. Text: Matthew 4:4
- B. Question: What are the most Powerful Words  
You have ever Heard?

## I. W\_\_\_\_\_ Have P\_\_\_\_\_!

- A. It is almost impossible to overstate this fact! Solomon said, “D\_\_\_\_\_ and L\_\_\_\_\_ are in the power of the T\_\_\_\_\_” (Proverbs 18:21)
- B. But let us ask, “W\_\_\_\_\_”?
  - 1. They deliver I\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2. They C\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 3. They are E\_\_\_\_\_ with meaning.
  - 4. They give shape to T\_\_\_\_\_.

## II. G\_\_\_\_\_ W\_\_\_\_\_ Has P\_\_\_\_\_!

- A. Hebrews 4:12 - Because it conveys His thoughts and ideas.
- B. Consider how great a blessing it is! Turn to Psalm 19
  - 1. His C\_\_\_\_\_ is marvelous but it pales in comparison to the One who made it. It testifies of His greatness. This is called G\_\_\_\_\_ Revelation (Rom 1:20-23)
  - 2. However David saw an even greater work of God, His W\_\_\_\_\_. This is His S\_\_\_\_\_ Revelation.
  - 3. Its true power can be seen in passages like 2 Peter 1:1, Romans 10:17, John 20:26-31, John 6:66, etc.
